#### **Swimming – All Parents**

The school's record in swimming is amongst the best in the country if not the best. Our school standard when the children leave us in Year Six is 150 metres minimum. When you appreciate the national expectation is 25 metres, you will understand why we are justifiably proud. In order to maintain this standard, we insist that, if your child is well enough to attend school, they are well enough to swim with us. Exceptions to this include medical advice from GP or specialist following treatment. This does not leave room for parents to opt out of swimming as it is an essential part of the PE curriculum. Children are more at risk of drowning than the common cold or tiredness.

#### **Congratulations County Choir**
