### **Parking Reminder**

**Please note that there is NO parent parking on site.**

This is to keep children safe as they enter and leave the site.

We do appreciate how limited our parking is and because of this would encourage you to walk if possible. Parking at Lidl's and walking up is an option. When parking around school is necessary, please, please respect our neighbours and consider how and where you are parking. Please consider when you park next to the pavement whether members of the public can safely get past without going onto the road. People who park illegally, i.e blocking driveways or on double yellow lines, run the risk of receiving a parking ticket as we have requested police presence to keep the area safe.

The only instance we allow parent parking on site in the morning is when using our DRIVE-THROUGH drop-off zone right at the front of school. This is manned by a member of staff in the morning and they will take younger children into school for you. Older

children can be quickly dropped off here and enter their classrooms independently.

We ask that you please respect the one-way system we have in place in the mornings and after school which means the traffic flow is ONLY UP Tremarren Road not down. This has helped so much with not only traffic flow but also safety.

If other family members or friends drop off / pick up your child PLEASE remember to inform them of these procedures. Thank you.

### **Harvest – 9.30 am Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> October**

Please come along to share with us this annual school event for Years 1 - 6. If you would like to donate produce this will be delivered to our local Food Bank.

Below is a list of the most urgently required items. You may wish to refer to this ....

Sugar, tinned tomatoes, tinned rice pudding, sponge pudding, sweets, chocolate, pet food, longlife fruit juice, jam, sauce for pasta, soap, shower gel, deodorant, toilet rolls and cleaning items.

### **Nuts**

Please remember we have several children in school with severe nut allergies and we therefore are a nut free zone. This includes all cakes, biscuits, sandwich spreads, etc which you might put in lunchboxes or kindly donate for school events. Please take time to check the ingredients label of all items.

These items should never come into school:

- **items which have nuts listed in their ingredients;**
- **items which say 'may also contain nuts';**
- **items which have sesame seeds in their ingredients;**
- **items which have sunflower seeds in their ingredients;**
- **pesto, as this contains pine nuts so must not come into school;**
- **houmous, as this contains sesame seeds so must not come into school.**

**Please be particularly aware of some crisps, biscuits, cake bars which say 'may also contain nuts' as they may not initially appear to have nuts in. Checking labels is a must.**

All other seeds are fine and items which say 'may contain traces of nuts' are fine.

Please be aware we have had to make some exceptions to this as we have children who have other food intolerances and are limited in their diet. As these are a minority we are able to put measures in place to ensure all children's safety. The majority of children MUST not have the above things in their lunch boxes. Thank you.

It's that time of year again and we need to organise the order of the day.

We will automatically have every child individually photographed for our school records. Any children with siblings who attend St Breock will also be photographed together. Parents are under no obligation whatsoever to purchase these photographs unless they wish to do so.
