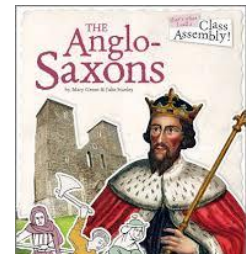


Autumn Term

Our Topic this term is on the Anglo-Saxons. Pupils will learn that The Anglo-Saxons were Germanic people from the areas of modern-day Germany, Denmark, and the Netherlands who migrated to Britain in the 5th and 6th centuries after the Roman withdrawal. They settled in the land that became known as "England" brought their language, (Old English) and customs, and formed various kingdoms.

Literacy

During our literacy lessons Children will demonstrate knowledge and understanding about the everyday lives of the Anglo-Saxons. They will study a newspaper article for its features and complete activities to help them understand the language and features needed in a newspaper. Children will write a newspaper report about the Battle of Hastings deciding whether to write it from the point of view of the Anglo-Saxons or the Normans, or whether to remain objective.

Mathematics

A significant amount of time this term will be spent reinforcing number in order to build competency and ensure children can confidently access the rest of the curriculum. Children will acquire depth of knowledge in each topic. Opportunities to revisit previously learned skills are built into later blocks.

Spellings

Spelling assignments will be set every week on Spelling Shed and will be in their spelling jotter each week along with morning maths activities.

Foundation Subjects

History

This term children will be learning about the Anglo-Saxons.

Design and Technology

This term children will research, design, make and evaluate a recipe fit for an Anglo- Saxon brunch.

Religious Education

This term children will explore why Hindus want to be good.

Personal Development

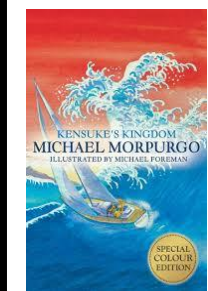
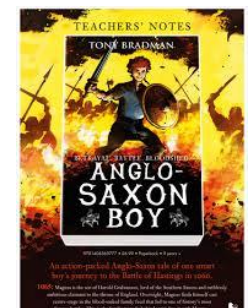
This term children will explore their hopes and fears for the year ahead.
