

In our current topic unit, students will immerse themselves in the vibrant and often tumultuous world of Tudor Britain, a period spanning from 1485 to 1603. This study begins with the end of the Wars of the Roses and the rise of the Tudor dynasty under Henry VII. A significant focus of our lessons is the reign of Henry VIII, where we explore his quest for an heir, the "Break with Rome," and the far-reaching consequences of the Reformation on English life.

English

Using a range of diary themed novels and model text to inspire our writing this term, children will write in a range of styles:

- Recount – diary entry
- Characterising speech
- Instruction writing
- Narrative writing

Mathematics

As your child progresses through the Year 5 mathematics curriculum, they will learn the mastery of multiplication by two-digit numbers it requires students to apply their understanding of place value through methods like the area model column method. Building upon this, division by single-digit divisors introduces the concept of partitioning totals into equal groups, a process that reinforces the inverse relationship between multiplication and division.

Foundation Subjects

History

This term children will be learning about Tudor Britain.

Design and Technology

This term children will research, design, make and evaluate a recipe for a vegetable spring roll.

Religious Education

This term children will explore why the Torah is important to Jewish people.

P.E


This term children will be learning these skills, balance, space, shape, jumps and leaps.
