## Attendance

As you know we monitor attendance regularly in school and this is also monitored externally by our Education Welfare Officer and the County attendance team. We have noticed that our authorised absences have increased to a point where they are now above the national average. We are very aware there are some extenuating circumstances surrounding this i.e the sickness bug that hit us before Christmas and a couple of other bouts of illness which have impacted on specific classes. That said moving forward we will be monitoring this more closely. This does not mean we want poorly children in school, absolutely not! However, when your child is off school we will ask you for the detail of the illness and after 3 days we will ask you to provide medical evidence for the absence to ensure steps are being taken to getting back to school as soon as possible and limit lost learning. Medical evidence can be evidence of an appointment, prescription or phone call. We appreciate this can feel tricky, but need to ensure we are doing all we can to keep children's attendance as high as possible.

Next week is Wadebridge Festival of Speech and Music and we are excited to be taking some of the children to take part. If your child is taking part you will have received a separate email with details.
