This week we have been so proud of all the children who have been taking part in Wadebridge Festival of Music and Speech. It is such a fantastic opportunity for the children to take part in such a super local tradition and we are delighted to be able to support it. The children showed bucket loads of courage and determination in performing, as it is not an easy thing to do and they are all winners for taking part!

This week I have also been bursting with pride for our school, as I had the opportunity to attend the Youth Sport Trust Conference in Telford and speak on a panel about the unique community we have created. We have been working as part of the Well Schools Movement for some time. This is a movement of over 2000 schools who are taking positive action to improve education outcomes by supporting the health and happiness of their pupils and staff across the UK. Last year we were chosen as one of only 20 primary and secondary schools in the country to be a Beacon Well School, which exemplifies a Well Culture under the three pillars of Lead Well, Live Well, Move Well. On Tuesday evening I attended the conference award ceremony, where we were one of the first schools nationally to be awarded the new Well Schools accreditation as a Five Star School! It is always wonderful to be recognised for all the dedication the staff provide. This dedication to creating an ethos and culture at our school, which has impact and is playing a small part in influencing how education of the future could be shaped.
