

# Year 1 Summer 2026



*This term, children will explore Jack and the Beanstalk, learn to write simple plant-growing instructions, investigate the seasons and the human body, discover the Great Fire of London, and enjoy creative projects such as making fruit kebabs and bird sculptures while continuing to build confidence in maths, phonics and personal development.*

## English

*Children will enjoy retelling Jack and the Beanstalk, acting out the story, planning their own version and writing sentences that build the beginning, middle and end, using capital letters, full stops and joining ideas with and. Children will learn how to write clear step-by-step instructions by exploring how plants grow, taking part in practical activities, talking through each stage together and then turning their ideas into simple written instructions that others can follow.*

## Mathematics

*Year 1 will focus on multiplication and division, fractions, position and direction, place value, money, and time, supporting problem-solving and providing a base for more mathematical concepts in the future.*

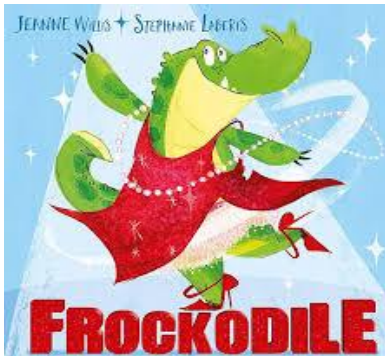
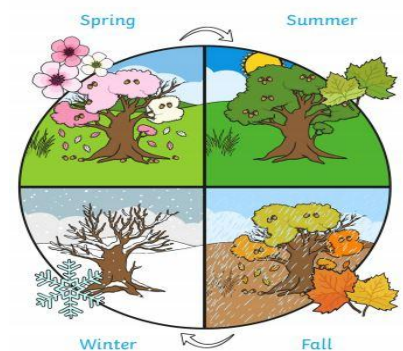
## Science
