What a mixed bag of weather we are having! Despite the changeable conditions we are obviously keen for the children to still spend as much time outdoors as possible so please do ensure that a wet weather coat comes into school to use during these unexpected downpours. It was fantastic to see our Y4s head off this week to Okehampton for their residential. They had a jam packed few days with canoeing, a trip to Exeter on the train, where they visited the cathedral and Exeter Gallery. Today they challenged themselves by taking to the high ropes and what a brave group of young people they are!

We are also especially proud of Y6s who this week completed their Statutory Assessment Tests (SATs). We don't make a huge deal of it all at St Breock, as we don't want to add to the pressure the children can feel. However, they all approached it with confidence and determination to do their best, which is all we would want. Y6 is not over yet though and they can now get on with enjoying their last 9 weeks with us all here.

Move Up

For those families that are new to St Breock you may not know that we do the end of the school year slightly differently. Our Y1-Y5 children move up to their new teacher for the last three weeks of term in July. We have had this in place for some time as we find it alleviates all the worries and concerns that can culminate in the move to a new class and new teacher over the summer holiday. We find that the children leave us at the end of term already settled into their new class and can then enjoy the summer holiday, looking forward to returning in September and ready for learning. We are closed for INSET on Monday 29th June and the children in Y1-Y5 start in their new classes on Tuesday 30th June. Our FS2 class remain in their current class for that week, with the Y1 teacher coming to spend time with them and then move to their new room on Monday 6th July. We are then able to welcome our new FS2 and Beacons children onto school over the last two weeks.

Our current Y6s go off for their Transition Days at Wadebridge Secondary on Monday 29th-Wed 1st July and then return to school on Thursday 2nd July, when they become known as Y6+ and are taught by myself for their remaining three weeks in school. Further details of all these plans will be sent out over the coming weeks.

Census Day

Thursday 21st May is Census Day. This is when the government collects information from all schools to determine funding for the following academic year. Some of this information can determine our funding for school meals, particularly universal free school meals and free school meals. We do ask that on this day all children in FS2, Y1, Y2 and those in KS2 entitled to a free school meal, have a school lunch. This is because if they don't we won't receive funding for them and when they do choose to have a meal in the future the school will have to cover the cost. There is always a special menu for the day and plenty of options available. We will of course not let anyone go hungry, so if you have any particular issues with your child having a lunch on this day please talk to their class teacher. Your support with this is greatly appreciated.
