PE & Sports Premium

Up until now this funding has been received directly by Primary Schools to increase children's engagement in PE, School Sport and physical activity, to ensure they are meeting the Chief medical officers recommendation of at least 60mins of physical activity a day. From September primary schools will no longer received this funding directly. They will receive access to activities, events, intervention and training via a regional delivery team. The details of this is yet to be announced.

At St Breock we have used the funding over the years to purchase equipment, fund activities, provide top up swimming, provide access to coaches from specialist sports amongst other things. We have also been able to use some of the funding towards our minibus so that we are easily able to access local competitions, events and trips. Our minibus is in constant use. We are now at huge risk of losing it, a decision many other schools have already had to take. This will have particular impact on swimming as we are able to use it, which heavily subsidises the transport element we charge back to you. Other schools are charging parents £50-£60 a term to cover coach travel. To avoid this we are looking for some sponsorship from local businesses or individuals. If you know a business or person who may be able to help support us with this we would love to hear from you as we would hate to lose this unique opportunity for the children. Do get in touch.
