Google Classroom

Following a review of our communication with our parent working group we have made some changes as to how we share pictures with you. For Y1-Y6 we will continue to use Facebook, but this will only be one or two photos to share something of note. You can gain access to Google Classroom via an app downloaded to your device or through our website and the child login icon halfway down the page. You will need to log in to Google Classroom with your child's email address. This will look something like fh04@iaspire.com. You do not need a code or password. If you are asked for a code this is because you are logged into Google as someone else. If you look at the top right corner you will see a coloured circle with a letter inside. If you click on this you will see who you are logged in as and may need to switch to your child's school email or add it as a new account. Your child's email address is in the back of their jotter. Should you not be able to locate it please let us know.
