Spring Term 2022

Spring 1

The theme for this half term is light and dark, linked to our science and literacy topics.

Literacy

- Learning to write a Tale of Fear based on 'The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark'.
- Sequencing a story, conjunctions, pronouns, description.
- Writing a persuasive letter to Blue Peter.
- Spelling - suffixes, homophones and the Year 3 word list.
- Vipers: reading comprehension.

Numeracy

- Place value - understanding 100s, 10s and 1s.
- Finding 1, 10 and 100 more or less than a given number.
- Compare objects and numbers to 1000.
- Addition and subtraction - add and subtract 100s.
- Adding and subtracting 1s and 10s to and from a three digit number.
- Adding and subtracting two and three digit numbers.
- Pattern spotting.

Science - We will learn about light and dark, reflection and refraction and shadows. We will use mirrors and make shadow puppet theatres.

History - We will be learning about Ancient Egypt, Tutankhamun and the pyramids.

Computing - Our main ICT focus will be in Spring 2 but we will embed ICT into lessons across the curriculum, particularly literacy.

DT - Look at various joins, using the strongest shape and make picture Frames.

PE - Swimming, gym and dance.

RE - Christianity - What is it like for someone to follow God?

Music - Music appreciation from a variety of genres. Use percussion & tuned instruments to accompany songs.

French - Greetings, introducing yourself and numbers 1-12.

PSHE - Jigsaw - Dreams and Goals
British Fundamental Values - Individual Liberty

Spring 2

This half term we will be taking a closer look at Ancient Egypt including learning about mummification!

Literacy

- Writing a 'Portal Story'.
- Instruction writing.
- Spelling - suffixes, spelling strategies and the Year 3 word list.
- Vipers: reading comprehension.

Numeracy

- Measurement: Length & Perimeter.
- Recognising non-unit fractions and equivalent fractions.
- Multiplication and division facts for 2, 5, 3, 4, 8x table.

Science - We will study the life cycle and parts of plants. We will learn what plants need to grow and collect data linked to this topic.

History - A continuation of our close study of Ancient Egypt and an overview of the first civilisations.

Computing - Understanding the importance of E-safety and screen time limits. Working in small groups to make and film a simple animation.

Art - Experimenting with light & dark: chiaroscuro.
Learning about artists Da Vinci & Caravaggio. Colour blocking, sketching, Using sketches to make collages.

PE - Swimming, gym and dance.

RE - Hinduism- What do Hindus believe that God is like?

Music - Our main music focus will be in Spring 1 but we will continue to listen to, discuss and appreciate music.

French - The months of the year, saying when your Birthday is and describing yourself.
